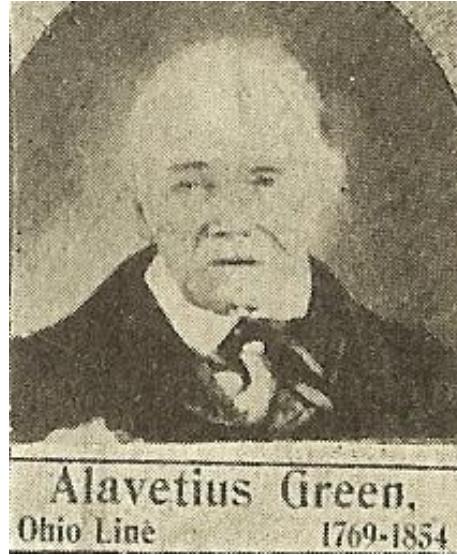


Alavetius Green
1769-1854



Born in Maryland, about 1769, Alavetius (Alivicivus in military records) Greene served as a private in Captain Riddle's Company, 1st Regiment, Ohio Militia. [His military records exist at the Archives but were not available in October 2012.]

He was married more than once. With his first wife (or wives), name unknown, he had many children, including a dozen or so who were in his household in Clark Co., Indiana, in 1820. That census also reported that two adults were working in manufacturing. The family was still living in Clark Co. in 1830. By 1837, they had moved to Bartholomew Co., where Alavetius was elected as one of the first five trustees of the town of Columbus.

There were at least half a dozen Green marriages in Bartholomew Co. between 1840 and 1850, that may be connected; but no additional information is available at the moment. Other descendants likely married in Clark Co. One daughter, Ann Permelia Green, was born July 26, 1808, Maryland. She married John B. Hunter in Clark Co. in 1828, and died in Bartholomew Co. in 1866. She's buried at City Cemetery near her father, his second wife, and his younger children.

At age 55, A.T. Green married Elizabeth Dietz, Feb. 7, 1824, in Clark Co., and began family life anew. Elizabeth was then 30, and Dietz may not have been her maiden name. They had six known children together: Elenora, Ann Delila, Alcander, George Allen, and Sarah E., all listed on Findagrave; and another son, whose burial isn't established. He was Hugh P. Green (Aug. 25, 1828-May 5, 1905). He died at Darlington, in Montgomery Co., IN.
